MedEdQR LLC ("us", "we", or "our") operates the <https://www.mededqr.com>, the <https://www.mededqr.biz> and the <https://www.mededqr.net> websites (hereinafter referred to as the "Service").

This page informs you of our policies regarding the collection, use and disclosure of personal data when you use our Service and the choices you have associated with that data.

We use your data to provide and improve the Service. By using the Service, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy. Definitions

Service

Service is the <https://www.mededqr.com>, <https://www.mededqr.biz>, and <https://www.mededqr.net> websites operated by MedEdQR LLC

Personal Data

Personal Data means data about a living individual who can be identified from those data (or from those and other information either in our possession or likely to come into our possession).

Usage Data

Usage Data is data collected automatically either generated by the use of the Service or from the Service infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a page visit).

Cookies

Cookies are small files stored on your device (computer or mobile device).

Data Controller

Data Controller means the natural or legal person who (either alone or jointly or in common with other persons) determines the purposes for which and the manner in which any personal information are, or are to be, processed.

For the purpose of this Privacy Policy, we are a Data Controller of your Personal Data.

Data Processors (or Service Providers)

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data : The MEDEDQR Mobile Application (Apple and Android)

No identifiable information is stored in the mobile applications.

Personal Data : MEDEDQR.NET

While using our Service, we may or your institution may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you ("Personal Data"). Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

- Email address
- First name and last name
- An arbitrary Cohort name
- A User ID which is NOT an account password)

We may use your Personal Data to contact you with newsletters, marketing or promotional materials and other information that may be of interest to you. You may opt out of receiving any, or all, of these communications from us by following the unsubscribe link or instructions provided in any email we send or by contacting us.

Additionally, while using our Service and as a result of using the MedEdQR mobile application, certain data is collected concerning your performance as you work through virtual patient cases. That information includes, but is not limited to:

- Tracking data for each case you access. This data includes what case information is accessed and a date/time stamp.
- Any assessment results such as quiz grades and the number of times a quiz is taken.
- Whether you have certified that you have completed a case.

Usage Data

We may also collect information on how the Service is accessed and used ("Usage Data"). This Usage Data may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol address (e.g. IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

Tracking Cookies Data

We use cookies and similar tracking technologies to track the activity on our Service and we hold certain information.

Cookies are files with a small amount of data which may include an anonymous unique identifier. Cookies are sent to your browser from a website and stored on your device. Other

tracking technologies are also used such as beacons, tags and scripts to collect and track information and to improve and analyse our Service.

You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some portions of our Service.

Examples of Cookies we use:

Retention of Data

Business Transaction

If MedEdQR LLC is involved in a merger, acquisition or asset sale, your Personal Data may be transferred. We will provide notice before your Personal Data is transferred and becomes subject to a different Privacy Policy.
